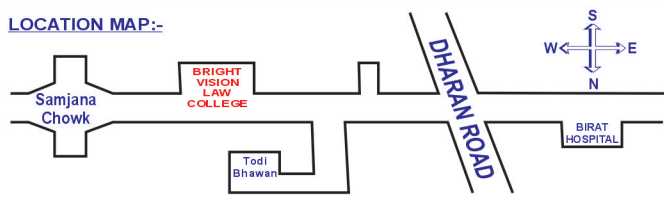
LL.M
